LICENCE EXTENSION

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

In accordance with Article 151 of the *Highway Safety Code*, the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (Quebec automobile insurance corporation) requires everyone who acquires road vehicles for business purposes to hold a business licence. Article 2 of the *Regulation Respecting Dealers and Recyclers* stipulates that issuance of a licence is subject to having a place of business. Moreover, Article 10 of the same document places a condition on the licence which dictates that sales of motor vehicles must be conducted from a single location which is the one spelled out on the licence. Infractions of these rules, according to Article 164 of the *Highway Safety Code*, are subject to a fine of \$300 to \$600.

There are special occasions on which a dealer can request an exemption from the regulation concerning a place of business, for example during a motorcycle show. To obtain such an exemption, **you must apply for a licence extension to the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec.**

How to obtain a LICENCE EXTENSION?

- Obtain from your insurer a letter which states that it has been informed of the intended commercial activity at a specified time and place.
- Attach to this letter:
 - a copy of the show space rental contract which identifies the parties, the locations and the dates of the activity as well as the signatures of representatives,
 - a cheque for \$25,
- Send by courier to the address given below.
